The journey that started about 25 years back in 1995, through the emotional act of a local inhabitant, Sri Balam Karan, by giving shelter to a hapless child of a nearby locality, has culminated to today's Bhabna Association for People's Upliftment, an orphanage per excellence, where a good number of destitute children are being brought up under the watchful eyes of the Ashram management. It is a fascinating story of a great journey, initiated by one single person, Sri Balam Karan, an inhabitant of the village, who impulsively brought home an unfortunate orphan in a chilly evening, whom he found desperately searching for food from a garbage bin, at an adjacent locality.

The orphanage, which was set up sometime in 1995 and it was registered in the year 2004 under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act. 1961.

The journey, which had started by saving one child, has culminated to today's Bhabna Association for People's Upliftment, giving shelter to about 170 hapless children. Sri Karan did not spare any efforts during the last two decades to provide them a place, they can call home.

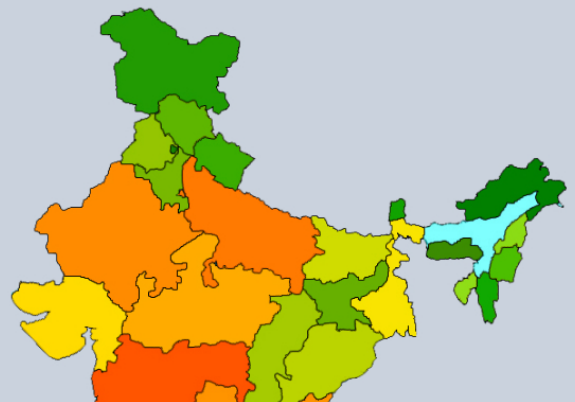

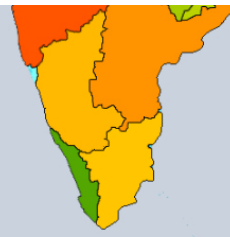
